- (3) For core jute machinery, the incentive payment is limited to approved enlisted vendors under ISAPM as submitted by IJIRA vide their letter no IJIRA/ISAPM/4583 dated 08.10.2015.
- (4) Original Invoice/s and documents of the above-mentioned machineries should be submitted by claimant in person along with certified bank statement countersigned by the Bank Manager with name and designation of the signatory.
- (5) Details of RTGS, Account No. on which the incentive to be transferred, IFS Code of the bank etc. is to be intimated along with the claim application.
- (6) Applicant should prepare a board as per format (enclosed as Annexure-1) and should place in the concerned department mentioning department-wise statement of machinery on which Subsidy & Incentive has been received from NJB under JTM and ISAPM respectively during last five years.
- (7) IJIRA has also prepared a template format (enclosed as Annexure-2) which is to be fixed on the gable of the machine before inspection on which claim of incentive will be made.
- (8) The incentive for these machines can't be claimed again under TUFs and other schemes under Government of India.
- (9) Kindly note that so far NJB has released a incentive of Rs. 3,82,000 against slab of Rs.2.50 Crore under this Scheme.
- (10) Please note this letter is only IPA, does not guarantee payment incentive, unless the claims are submitted within one year with required document and satisfactory completion of inspection during the claims submission.
