Agenda 1: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 12thTechnical Committee under ISAPM held on 16th March'2018

- 4.2 Regarding inclusion of Solar Rooftop Plant under ISAPM, the pros and cons of such inclusion under the Scheme were discussed in details and the Committee approved the proposal for inclusion in the list of eligible non-core jute machinery for the interest of renewable energy sourcing device which is being used by Jute mills.
- 4.3 Regarding inclusion of i) Folding & Stacking Attachment after Rotary / Guillotine Cutting Machine and ii) Bag stacking attachment after Branding / Printing machine under ISAPM, the Committee approved the proposal for inclusion in the list of eligible core jute machinery.

Agenda 5: Replacing Wooden Staves with Metalog Staved in Breaker & Finisher Card

The proposal of M/s Lagan Engineering Co. for replacement of wooden staves with metalog staves in the Breaker Card & Finisher Card approved by the Committee. Committee directed to IJIRA to update the price list accordingly.

The replacement of wooden staves by metalog staves approved in principle for other manufacturer also.

Agenda 6: Representation of RDB Textiles

The Committee noted that some representation are received regarding rejected cases by NJB and directed to constitute a committee for examining the cases which were rejected on specific ground and may be placed in the next TC meeting. The Committee may allow the representative from the concerned Jute mill / JDP unit for personal hearing to represent their cases as deemed fit.

Agenda 7: Any other issues with the permission of the Chair

After closing the online application for availing incentive under ISAPM due to budgetary constrain, some jute mills / MSME units intimate their proposed project manually to NJB for further consideration. The Committee noted the issue and opined to take-up the issue separately to the Ministry with a request to continue the Scheme with budgetary support for further deliberation.
