The inaugural ceremony was followed by speeches and lectures of eminent geotechnical engineers/academicians on the theme of the conference—"Geotechnical Engineering for a Sustainable Tomorrow".

NJB displayed technical literature, photo blow-ups as well as live samples of JGT at the stall allotted to National jute Board in its exhibition venue. About 500 delegates registered in IGC 2024. More than 200 technical papers were presented during the 3- day conference under the theme of the conference—"Geotechnical Engineering for a Sustainable Tomorrow".

More than 100 delegates visited NJB stall and among them about 50 number delegates had shown keen interest on JGT. As enquired by the visitors a detailed discussion regarding efficacy of JGT in various civil engineering applications were held. Many academicians were also very eager to undertake research work on the behaviour of JGT in road construction. It was informed from this end that they may approach NJB for the same.
